United Croquet Club Grades of membership

In addition to the club subscription, members must pay affiliation fees to:

- Canterbury (NZ) Croquet Association Incorporated
- Croquet New Zealand (also known as the New Zealand Croquet Council)

Full

A full member is entitled to the full rights and privileges of the club. This includes:

- participation in all events of the club
- the use of the lawns and equipment, club rooms and other buildings
- playing in club competitions including representing the club in association and national competitions.
- voting in all general meetings
- election or appointment to the executive committee or its sub-committees.

Discounts: Where more than one full member of the same or immediate family resides at the same address then each gets a 15% discount on the Full Club subscription.

Student

Student membership is available to someone in full-time education. Student members are entitled to the same rights as a full member.

- Full-time education means a course recognised by Studylink New Zealand as a full time course
- Club subscription: Half of Full

Novice

Novice membership is available only to those new to croquet. Novice members are entitled to the same rights as a full member.

- Club subscription: First season: Half of Full; Second: 30% discount on Full; Thereafter: Same as Full.

Youth

For those aged 13 to 18 years on the 31 October of the new season.

Limited membership to allow time to get to know the game without being involved to the same extent as a Full member.

- Entitlements: Sub-committee; General duties; Club Championship; Representing the Club in Canterbury and National competitions; Club Days; Use of equipment; Use of Club Room; Social Events and Newsletter.
- Note: If joining after 30 November then age is taken at 31 March of the same season.
- Club subscription: Quarter of Full.

Child

For those aged 0 to 12 years on the 31 October of the new season.

- Same conditions as youth membership.
- Note: CNZ levy is reduced for child 0 to 12 years.

Associate

Available to a player who pays levies at another Croquet Club.

- Entitlements: General duties; Club Days; Use of equipment; Use of Club Room; Social Events and Newsletter.
- Club subscription: Half of Full.

Winter

Available to a player who pays levies at another Croquet Club.

- Entitlements: General duties; Club Days; Use of equipment; Use of Club Room; Social Events and Newsletter outside the normal playing season, subject to weather.
